- WHO:** **Dual Meet:** University of Alberta vs University of Calgary,
 Select events open to: Clubs, Registered Schools and Athletes from Alberta
- WHAT:** **Dual Field Events:** Shot Put, Weight Throw, Long Jump, Triple Jump, High Jump, Pole Vault
Dual Track Events: 60m, 60m Hurdles, 300m, 600m, 1000m, 3000m, 4x200m, 4x800m
Open Events: All events offered with one exception: Long, Triple, High Jumps only if there's room and at meet directors discretion due to time constraints on field events if fields get too large.
- HOW:** **Dual:** U of A vs U of C athletes only, points awarded as per point section below among university athletes only.
Open: Track & Field events run with the Dual but finish position will not displace university athletes from points in Dual competition. Best possible fields will be created using current accurate seed times.
- COST:** **Open Events:** \$10 per event.
